

## Electric Heat Credit Program

Lacreek Electric will pay a credit of 1.2 cents per kilo Watt hour for all separately metered electric heat. For example, a member using 1,000 kWh of electric heat would receive a credit of \$12.00.

Lacreek Electric will furnish the heat metering equipment free of charge for consumer installations. There will be a \$25.00 charge if Lacreek Electric installs the equipment.

Persons paying for separately metered electric heat must meet the following criteria:

- At least 75% of the home must be wired with permanently installed electric heat.
- Electric heat must be the home's primary heat source.
- The heat meter must be located outside the home.

The electric heat credit is given for seven months—October 1 to April 30. During these months, the member receives a reading request for the heat meter. The reading must be returned to the office prior to the 20th of each month for the credit to be included on the member's next bill.

## Electric Water Heater Incentive Program

To provide Lacreek Electric's members an incentive to use electricity for residential water heating and to promote the use of electricity, Lacreek's board of directors offer the following:

- Any new electric water heater installation \$2.00 per gallon of capacity rebate. (New Units Only)
- Replacing a propane or fuel oil water heater with a new electric water heater \$4.00 per gallon of capacity rebate. (New Units Only)

**To qualify, the member must:**

- ✓ Permanently install the water heater on an account served by Lacreek Electric.
- ✓ Fill out an electric application form and include a dated sales ticket.
- ✓ Have the installation inspected and verified by an employee of the cooperative.
- ✓ Sign up for water heater load control program.
- ✓ Purchase water heater with required minimum of .90 energy factor.

The member may purchase any brand of water heater from the dealer of his or her choice. Lacreek Electric does encourage its members to select an energy efficient model with sufficient capacity to meet their needs.

Rebates for a water heater is limited to once every 10 years for the same residence.

## Electric Heat Incentive Program

Lacreek Electric also offers the following program for members who install and use efficient residential electric heating systems.

- \$150 per ton for an air-to-air heat pump.  
(New Units Only)  
Required minimum: Energy Star minimum criteria
- \$250 per ton for a ground-source heat pump.  
(New Units Only)  
Required minimum: Energy Star minimum criteria

**To qualify, the member must:**

- ✓ Permanently install the electric heat on an account served by Lacreek Electric.
- ✓ Complete an application form and include a dated sales ticket.
- ✓ Have the installation inspected and verified by an employee of the cooperative.

The member may purchase any brand of heating system from the dealer of his or her choice. Lacreek encourages members to select an energy efficient system with sufficient capacity to meet their needs.

Application forms are available at the office or by mail.

**Low interest loans for electric heat equipment are available for qualifying members at Lacreek Electric. Inquire at the Lacreek office for more details.**
